



CARROLL COUNTY, MARYLAND

Carroll County's 456 square miles of rolling hills are located in the piedmont region of north central Maryland. Founded in 1837 from portions of Baltimore and Frederick counties, Carroll's topography, climate and soil conditions have historically welcomed farm related industry. In Maryland and the nation, Carroll consistently ranks as one of the top counties for placing land in permanent agricultural preservation.

Carroll's eight incorporated municipalities each have their own distinct character and three are designated "Main Street" communities. Many other smaller villages like Uniontown, Snydersburg and Keymar retain the charm and neighborliness of years gone by. Traveling Carroll's two-lane back roads provides many a pleasant surprise: a country store with homemade ice cream; the log cabin where America's first Methodists worshiped and areas of Civil War interest like Union General George Meade's Pipe Creek Defensive Line.

The Carroll County Farm Museum, a major destination situated on 140 acres in the county seat of Westminster, holds many favorite annual events. The museum hosts The Maryland Wine Festival® the third weekend of September each year and other popular gatherings include the Old-Fashioned 4th of July Picnic, Fall Harvest Days and Steam Show Days. The Union Mills Homestead, one of the nations oldest operating grist mills, also hosts traditional events like the Old-Fashioned Corn Roast and the Maryland Microbrewery Festival. Volunteer fire companies still provide some of the best hometown recreation with annual carnivals, strawberry festivals, and scrumptious turkey and ham dinners. McDaniel College, located in Westminster, is home to the NFL's Baltimore Ravens summer camp and hosts theatre productions at Alumni Hall throughout the year.
